Medicines in school

Our school medicine policy has changed this term. Staff at Mountnessing School, are only allowed to administer medicines prescribed by a doctor, dentist, nurse prescriber or pharmacist prescriber. Medicines should always be provided in the original container as dispensed by a pharmacist and include the prescriber's instructions for administration.

Only in exceptional circumstances will the school administer medicine that is prescribed 3 times daily as normally this can be taken before school, after school and at bedtime. Medicine prescribed 4 times daily will be administered by staff in school.

We are unable to accept medicines that have been taken out of their original container or make changes to dosages on parental instructions.
