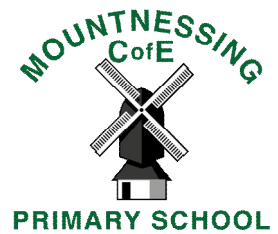

Scarlet Fever

There has been a case of Scarlet Fever in KS1 this is contagious disease but treatable by antibiotics. Children can return to school 24 hours after starting antibiotics unless otherwise advised by their GP. Sore throat and high temperature (fever) are the typical first symptoms. A bright red (scarlet) rash then soon develops.
