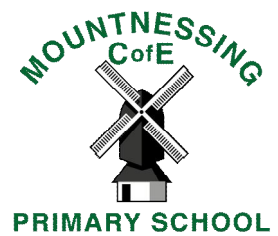

Next week year 6 children will be taking their SAT tests each day. Below is a timetable outlining the tests on each day.
