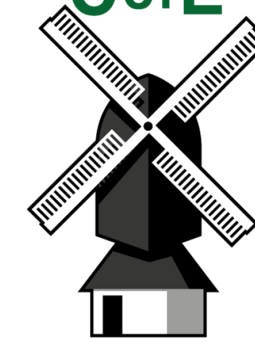
The child will:
